MCFGC CLUB PISOL MATCH REMINDER

PISTOL MATCH- 10:00 A.M. SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2023

Remember that you must be present at SAFETY BRIEFING (9:45 A.M.) to be eligible to shoot the match!

Pistol range closes at 9:00 A.M. to allow setup.

This will be an six(6) stage Official Steel Challenge match with at least two(2) classified stages. Three(3) squads with 12 guns per squad. Maximum of two(2) guns per shooter. Bring at least 300 rounds of ammo (qty. for one(1) gun). Open to members and public.

NOTE TO ALL SHOOTERS: You must have eye and ear protection on range. Unloaded guns must be in a case or pistol pouch, and are never presented until the range officer gives the command to make ready. This is a cold range. That means no handling of any firearms anywhere except the designated Safe Area tables in each bay or under the supervision of a Range Officer (RO). This includes the parking lot. If your competition firearm is loaded, let one of our staff know and we'll proceed to a bay to clear it.

Try to be at range by 9:15 A.M. to assist with setup and to check in so we may begin promptly. Checkin and safety briefing will take place outside the clubhouse.

PLEASE PRE-REGISTER AND PAY ONLINE

Match fee is \$15.00 for club members and \$20.00 for non-members You must pre-register and pay through Practiscore. There will be no walk-ons and no money taken at the match.

Safety area for malfunctions and function check can be found to the right of the pistol bays, under the trap shoot shelter. **NO AMMO IN SAFETY AREA EVER!** You may load magazines and handle ammo anywhere on range but SAFETY AREA.

To help make matches run smoothly, we ask that everyone help set up, paint targets, reset targets, and tear down. If you are not shooting or the shooter on deck, please help paint between shooters.

DIVISIONS

CENTERFIRE

Any pistol firing (9mm/.38 Special) or larger ammunition.

OPEN- This is the race division! All legal firearms are allowed. Optics and compensators are specifically allowed.

LIMITED-(LTD)- Any iron-sighted pistol without a compensator, barrel ports, or optical sight. Fiber optic inserts are specifically allowed.

PRODUCTION-(PROD)- Any double action or safe action pistol on the USPSA Production gun list. Holsters must follow USPSA Competition Rules for the Production Division except as specifically noted.

SINGLE STACK-(SS)- 1911 models only. Holsters must follow USPSA Competition Rules for the Single Stack Division.

REVOLVER- Any revolver can be used for competition. Fiber optic inserts are specifically allowed. No barrel length or holster restrictions. No restrictions for maximum rounds.

OPTIC SIGHT REVOLVER-(OSR)- A revolver equipped with Electronic/Optical Sights.

IRON SIGHT REVOLVER-(ISR)- A revolver equipped with iron sights. Fiber optic inserts are

CARRY OPTICS-(CO)- A double action or safe action/striker-fired semi-automatic pistol equipped with an optic sight. Compensators or ports are not allowed.

RIMFIRE

Open to any pistol/rifle firing .22 long rifle ammunition.

RIMFIRE PISTOL OPEN-(RFPO)- This is the Rimfire race divistion. All legal Rimfire firearms are allowed. Optics and compensators are specifically allowed.

RIMFIRE PISTOL IRON SIGHTS-(RFPI)- Any Iron-sighted Rimfire pistols without optic sights. Fiber-optic sight inserts are specifically allowed.

RIMFIRE RIFLE OPEN-(RFRO)- This is the Rimfire rifle race division. All legal Rimfire rifles are allowed. Optics and compensators are specifically allowed.

RIMFIRE RIFLE IRON SIGHTS-(RFRI)- Any Iron-sighted Rimfire rifle without optic sights. Fiber-optic sight inserts are specifically allowed.

PISTOL CALIBER CARBINE

Open to carbines shooting pistol caliber cartridges (9mm/.38 special/.40 S&W/10MM/.357 Sig/.45 ACP).

PISTOL CALIBER CARBINE OPEN-(PCCO)- This is the Pistol Caliber Carbine race division. All legal Pistol Caliber Carbines, to include short-barreled rifles, are allowed. Optics and compensators are specifically allowed.

PISTOL CALIBER CARBINE IRON SIGHTS-(PCCI)- Any iron-sighted rifle without optic sights. Fiber-optic inserts are specifically allowed.
